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Lower Lakes offers an ideal setting to forget the hubbub of daily routine and bury yourself amongst the pages of a gripping novel.

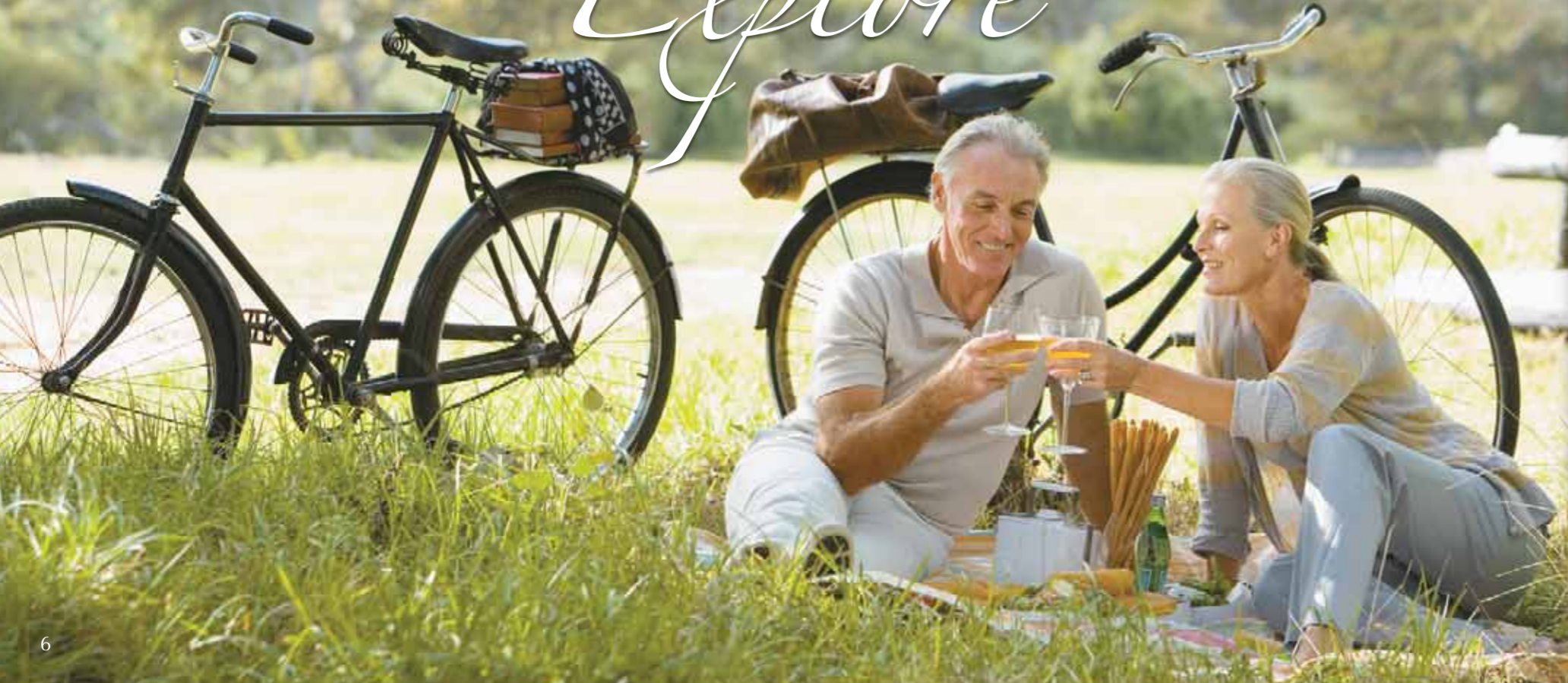

Not only does this cabin have all the home comforts but also has extras including a Jacuzzi bath tub and underfloor heating throughout. There is lots of space and the covered veranda is ideal for relaxing and enjoying the views.

The ground floor is open-plan with a spacious lounge and dining area overlooking the lake.

Comprises of two bedrooms, a shower room, and an open plan kitchen and lounge diner with excellent views across the lake. There is also outdoor seating right on the lakeside.

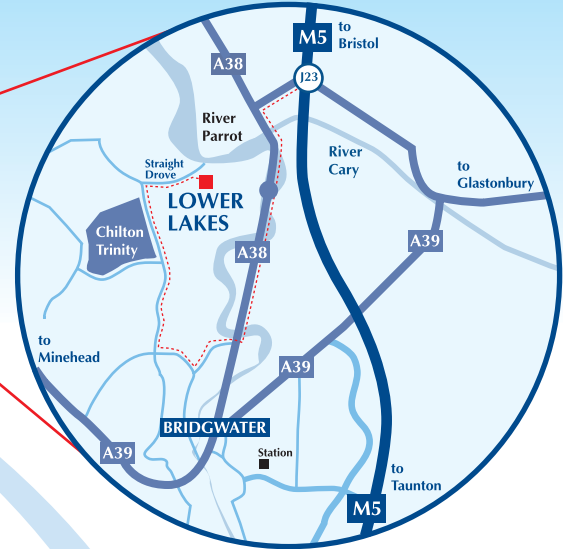
This property commands the best view of the lake and would be perfect for fishermen wanting to fish from just in front of their window.
